In 2015, the Cherry Blossom Giving Circle is offering unrestricted grants between \$500 and \$4,000. We are a group of volunteers committed to creating positive change in the Asian American/ Pacific Islander (AAPI) communities of the Washington, DC metropolitan area. Since 2009, we have pooled our resources to give out nearly \$46,000 in grants to 12 nonprofit organizations that serve local AAPI communities.

The number and actual size of the grants will be based on the number of applicants and the amount of funding resources available. If you wow us with your organization or project explained in your application, you could receive one of them.

### Question 1: Provide the following information about your organization.

- Amount of grant funds requested (between \$500 and \$4,000)
- How you learned about the Cherry Blossom Giving Circle and this application

### Question 2: Please answer the following questions about the following criteria.

- Show us that your organization has 501(c)(3) status or that your organization has a fiscal sponsor with 501(c)(3) status. Refer us to *CONNECT! Guide*<sup>1</sup> if applicable, or attach the 501(c)(3) tax determination letter.
- We are accepting applications only for organizations or projects that have budgets under \$500,000. Please check yes if your budget is under \$500,000.
